Vinification:

Traditional vinification mainly in thermo regulated concrete vats but also in small stainless steel tanks. Maceration lasts 2 to 5 days at maximum 15°C. Vatting lasts 4 weeks. Malolactic fermentation in new oak barrels for one part of the production. Aging in barrels during 12 to 14 months (50% new barrels each year).

Tasting Notes:

Deep garnet color. Fresh nose with red berries aromas with hints of vanilla. Silky tannins. Well balance.

Selling points

- 3 National Listed Monuments purchased by the family in 1850: L'Ermitage, Trinity Chapel (XIIIth century) and catacombs
- Possibility to organize a private visit of major monuments in Saint-Emilion
- Château Laniote, in La Filolie family for 2 centuries
- Arnaud and Florence de la Filolie's son is the 9th generation
