



DOMAINE ROUSSET

Region: Northern Rhône (Crozes-Hermitage) Village: Érôme

Winemaker: Stéphane Rousset

Property: 12 Hectares

Stéphane and Robert Rousset's family goes back 11 generations in Crozes-Hermitage. Stéphane's great uncle was the legendary Raymond Roure. This is how the Rousset's came into their parcel of the Les Picaudières in Gervans.

While the production is mainly Syrah, Stéphane has 3.5 hectares of his holdings planted to Marsanne and Roussanne. The Roussanne is a rather new addition to Rousset's whites, with production only beginning in 2017. While the Roussanne is interesting to see here, the Marsanne growing in their parcels is some of the finest in the appellation.

CROZES-HERMITAGE ROUGE

100% Syrah from the communes of Érôme, Gervans, and Crozes-Hermitage.

Soil: Granite with some limestone/clay

The vines on average are 50 years old.

The vineyards here are planted on terraces, so all work is done manually.

The fruit is vinified separately by elevation and aged separately until final assemblage for bottling.

The wine is aged 30% in concrete tank and 70% in 1-7 year old burgundy barriques for 16 to 18 months before bottling.
