



VOLKER EISELE - Napa

Volker Eisele Family Estate is situated in the Chiles Valley District, a sub-appellation of the Napa Valley American Viticultural Area. Cloaked in frequent Pacific fog, and with elevations of 600-1200 feet, the Chiles Valley District is one of the cooler areas of the Napa Valley

The Estate's sixty acres of vineyard grow at elevations of 900 to 1100 feet on east, west and south facing slopes as well as on the valley floor. Soils vary from clay-loam to shale. The majority of the vineyard is planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, followed by Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Semillon, and Sauvignon Blanc.

Since 1974 the Eisele's have enriched the vineyard soils through use of organic farming practices. No herbicides, pesticides or chemical fertilizers have been used. The vineyard is certified as organic by both the California Certified Organic Farmers and the California Department of Food and Agriculture.

Cabernet Sauvignon 2016

78% Cabernet Sauvignon and 22% Merlot

Harvest: Five separate passes September 25th through October 2nd 2016.

Oak Aging: 22 months in 50% new French oak barrels from Treuil cooperage (i.e. Allier and Tronçais).
